



Doctor of Natural Resources *honoris causa* Anake Angus Murray Goodall

This honorary doctorate conferred by Lincoln University on Anake Angus Murray Goodall acknowledges the high significance of the recipient's multifarious contributions to public and private sector life in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Among work, spanning four decades and two cultures, Māori and Pākehā, Anake's service connected with Ngāi Tahu's Treaty Settlement stands toweringly in the record of his career and must be mentioned first and foremost.

He was Ngāi Tahu's Claims Manager during its Settlement negotiations; he was then Settlement Implementation Manager and CEO of Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu charged with consolidating the iwi's organisation after formalisation of the Settlement and delivering beneficial outcomes for iwi members. It was his role to embed Ngāi Tahu values, voices and faces across the iwi's portfolio of responsibilities and ensure the development of on-going intergenerational growth.

Connections with Lincoln University stand tall too. In 2017 Anake was a member of the Lincoln University Transformation Board which, through its recommendations and guidance, delivered Lincoln University into the operational environment in which it now flourishes.

The Chancellor at the time, Steve Smith, described Anake's contribution to the Board glowingly: "Anake at the Board table was quiet in manner, but when he spoke everyone listened intently. He is an extremely impressive person and his contribution to the Transformation Board, in addition to providing the essential Māori perspective, was to constantly challenge our thinking, in the best possible way."

Beyond the Treaty Settlement and Lincoln University's Transformation Board, the full record of Anake's mahi could easily fill a second citation! Roles past and present include: Canterbury University Adjunct Professor; Harvard alumnus; Harkness Fellow; Ngāi Tahu Research Centre staff member; Lincoln University Lecturer; union delegate; Establishment Board member for the Environment Protection Authority and Te Pā o Rākaihautū; Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Authority member; Director, Meridian Energy; and Chair, The Christchurch Foundation.

In summary, Anake Angus Murray Goodall is a most worthy recipient of the Lincoln University degree Doctor of Natural Resources *honoris causa*.
